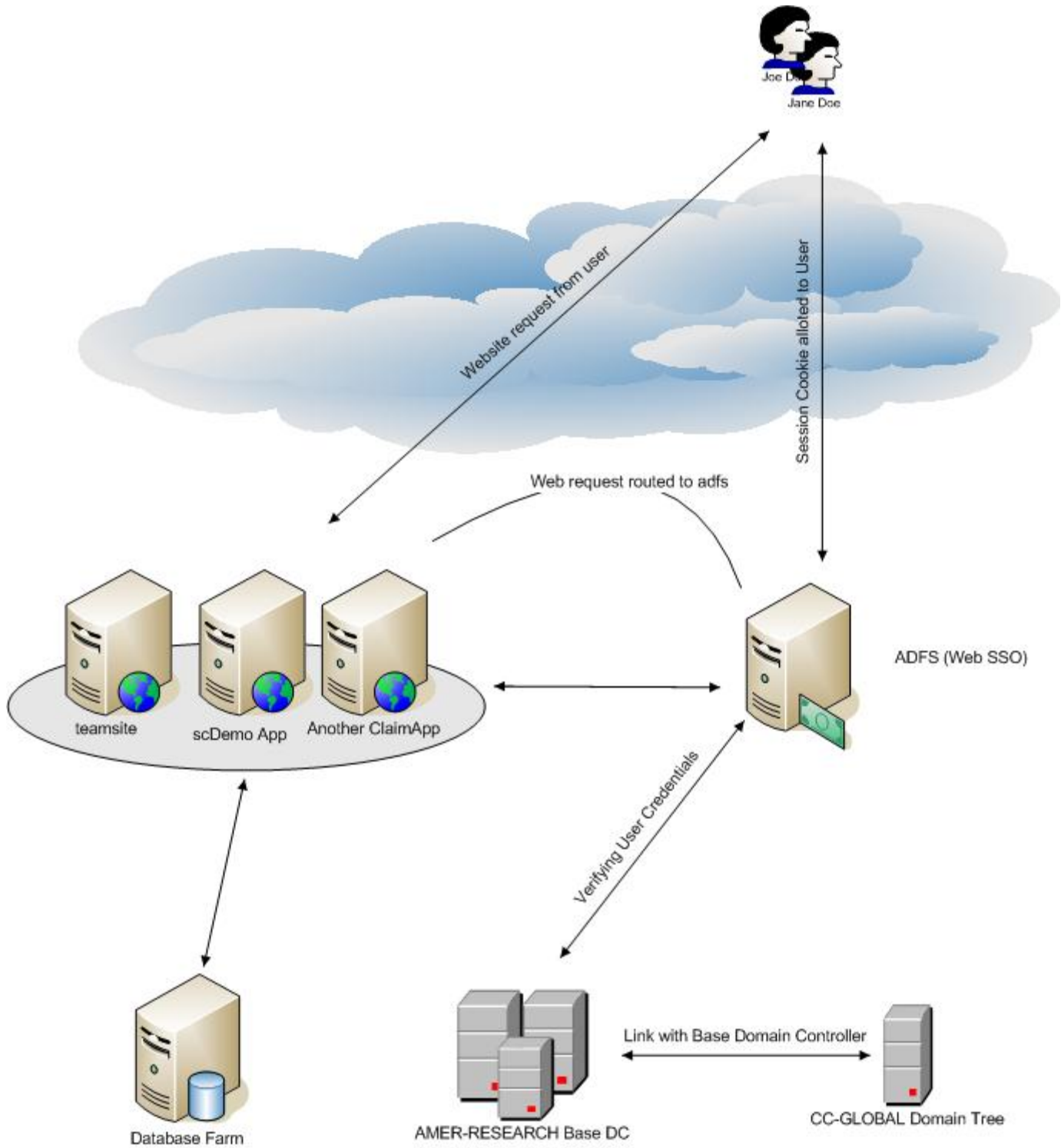


Client Problem

Active Directory Federation Services (ADFS) is a component in Microsoft® Windows Server™ 2003 R2 that provides Web single-sign-on (SSO) technologies to authenticate a user to multiple Web applications over the life of a single online

session. ADFS accomplishes this by securely sharing digital identity and entitlement rights, or "claims," across security and enterprise boundaries.

Microsoft Windows SharePoint Services 3.0 provides support for federated authentication scenarios where the authentication system is not local to the computer that hosts Windows SharePoint Services 3.0. Federated authentication systems are also known as Web single sign-on (SSO) systems. With Active Directory Federation Services (ADFS), people in one company can access servers hosted by a different company by using their existing Active Directory accounts. ADFS also establishes a trust relationship between the two companies and a seamless one-time logon experience for end users. ADFS relies on 302 redirects to authenticate end users. Users are issued an authentication token (cookie) after they are authenticated.
